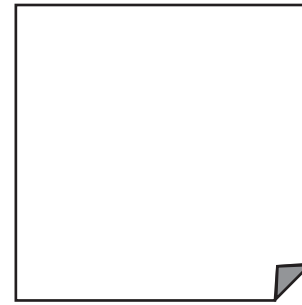

## Flower Fold .....

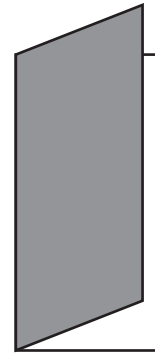


① Start with a square piece of paper.

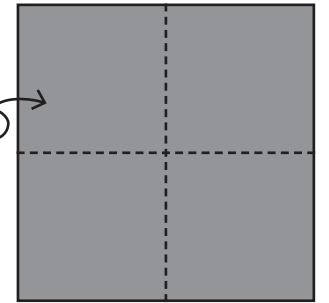
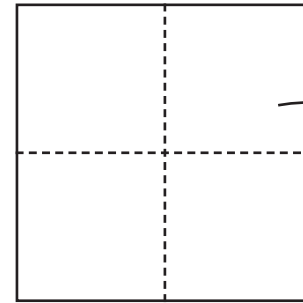
② Fold it in half to crease it then open it back up.



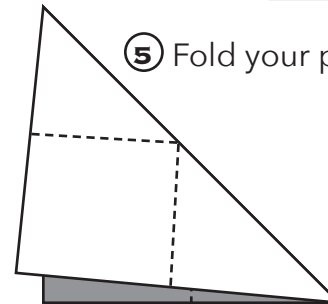
③ Fold it in half the other way to make a crease and again open it up.



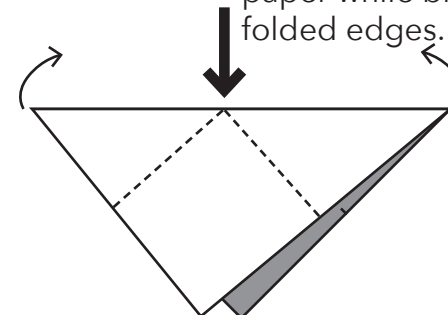
④ Flip your paper over.



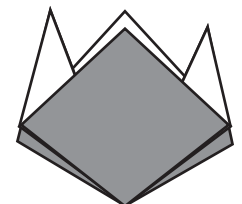
⑤ Fold your paper on a diagonal.



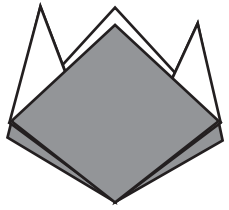
⑦ Push down in the middle of the paper while bringing up the folded edges.



⑧ Ta da!  
Flower fold!



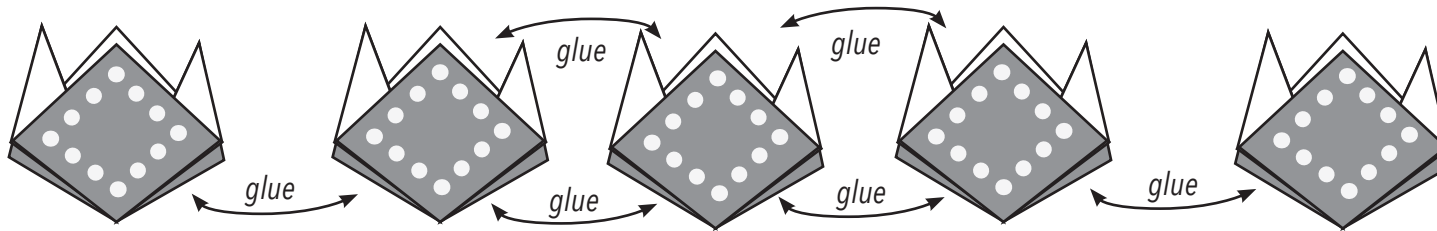
Now to assemble your book...



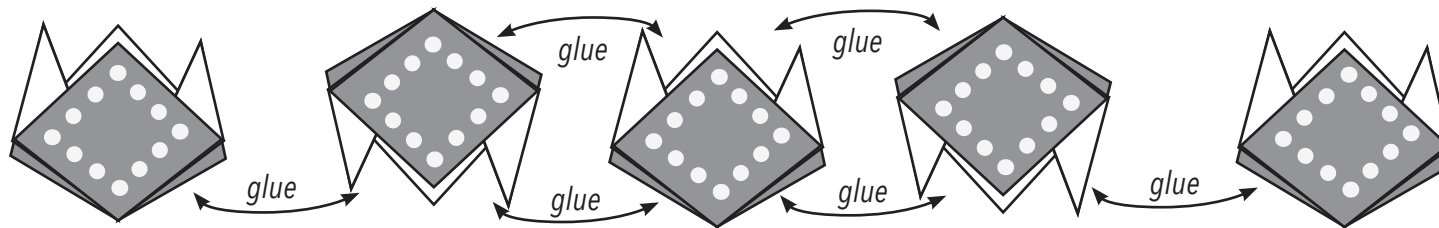
Glue 5 flower folds together. There are many options for this and I encourage you to be creative!

The two traditional ways are:

① Openings all facing UP!



② Openings alternating up and down



Whichever way you glue your flower fold book together, glue the covers to the first and last 'page' of the book.
